## Faculty Advisor

Your faculty advisor can help you plan your academic and future goals, keep you on-track for graduation, and provide referrals to campus services.

START HERE!

**UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS** will have three types of advisors during their course of study: A **First-Year advisor** who is a full-time faculty member from Experimental and Foundation Studies, a **Major advisor** from the full-time faculty in the student's chosen department, and a **Liberal Arts advisor** assigned from the full-time faculty in the Liberal Arts division.

**GRADUATE STUDENTS** are typically advised by the **Graduate Program Director**, and may also be assigned an advisor from the full-time faculty in their department.

Students pursuing a concentration work with a **Concentration Coordinator** to plan courses that will meet concentration requirements.
