



“Ad Hoc” Student Conduct Board Addendum:

While RISD is currently operating largely remotely due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Student Affairs and the Office of Student Conduct are committed to continuing to ensure a fair and equitable process for student conduct matters. Starting effective immediately and with the approval of the Assistant Vice President of Student Affairs, we will follow an “ad hoc” hearing panel model for any cases going to a Conduct Board, as provided in Section VI(D)(2) Procedures, Definitions of Process, Student Conduct Board of the Code of Student Conduct (<https://policies.risd.edu/student-life/code-of-student-conduct/>)

The panel may be made up of staff and/or faculty, and/or students based on availability and regardless of affiliation. The Coordinator of Student Conduct or designee will act as chair and shepherd the process remotely, and all hearings will be conducted remotely via the “ZOOM” Platform. Details on accessing case material, times of hearings, etc. will be communicated to the participants prior to the hearing.
